

C.O.P.E. CENTER NORTH NURTURING CENTER ARRIVAL/DISMISSAL PLAN DURING COVID-19

DAILY HEALTH SCREENING AT ENTRY FOR FAMILIES

- Parents/guardians are encouraged to take their child's temperature before coming to the facility and monitor them for all signs of illness or potential illness.
- We will conduct a daily wellness screening upon arrival of every child.
 - Parents will be asked to confirm that the child does not have fever, shortness of breath or cough.
 - They will be asked to confirm that no one in the home is exhibiting these symptoms.
- If a child shows visible symptoms of being sick, they will not be allowed into the nursery until a wellness check has been completed by the school nurse.

DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP TO MAINTAIN PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- Nurturing Center (NC) students will remain in the cafeteria, with their mothers, until called by room numbers. Students in infant rooms 1 and 2 will enter through Room #008 (*Closest to the Main Office*). Students in Infant rooms 3 and 4 will enter through Room #008 (*Closest to the NC office*). Toddlers in Toddler room 1 will enter through Room #008 (*Closest to NC office*). Toddlers in Toddler rooms 2 and 3 will enter their rooms respectively.
- Parents will be asked to continuously wear a mask or face covering and adhere to the social distancing markers remaining separate until a staff member meets them at the door.
 - Nurturing Center personnel will receive the child and bring them into the classroom.
 - Children will immediately have their hands and face washed upon entering the nursery.
 - Diaper bags and bookbags will be tagged and placed onto the class cart to be sanitized before being brought into the room. For the time being, parents are encouraged to minimize the size of the bag to accommodate only necessary items.
- In the presence of the parent, the Child Care Director and Assistant Director will record arrival and departure times of all infants and toddlers in place of parent signatures.
- Only Nurturing Center staff, the site principal, and on-campus medical personnel will be allowed to enter the nursery.
- Pick-up will proceed with parents being called by their child's NC classroom. Students with more than one baby will pick up both children at the same time. After the child's classroom is called, parents will pick their child up and proceed to the school bus for dismissal.
